ORDINANCE BILL NO. 4 FOR 1920 ORDINANCE NO. 255

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FORA PARK COMMISSION? AND FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF ALL PUBLIC PARKS AND PLAY GROUNDS IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, 2 AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE MANER OF ELECTING MENERS OF SUCH COMMISSION AND THEIR TWRMS OF OFFICEM AND NAMING THE FIRST 3 MEMBERS OF SAID

COMMISSION.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1 - There is hereby created a Park Commission for the 6 City of Lebanon, Oregon, to consist of Seven Members, at least four 7 of whom shall be men, and four of whom shall constitute a quorum 8 to transact business. The said Commission to be known as THE PARK 9 BOARD. 10

SECTION 2- The Mayor and no member of the Council while acting 11 as such officer shall be eligible to act as a Park Commissioner or 12 on the Park Board. 13

SECTION 3- The following persons are hereby appointed to com-14 pose and comprise the first Park Board as such Commissioners and 15 to serve for the following terms, to-wit:-16

Bert A. Millsap to serve for a term of One Year 17 Albert F. Wilson to serve for a term of wwo years J. G. Gill to serve for a term of three years 18 Dennis Cormier to serve for a term of Four years S. P. Bach to serve for aterm of five years 19 A. M. Reeves to serve for a term of six years J. C. Mayer to serve for a term of Seven years.

The said commissioners shall serve until the end of the term for which they have been severally been elected and until their successors have seen duly elected and confirmed as hereinafter provided. SECTION 4- At the expiration of the term of office of any of the said Commissioners, or in caze of a vacancy by resignation, death, or otherwise, the office shall be filled by the election of a successor by the remaining members of the Board, and if the said Election be for a member at the expiration of a term then the member shallbe elected for a term of geven years; and if it be to full a cacancy then, for the balance of the term for which the predecessor was bhosen All election made by members of the said Commission shall be reported to the Council and confirmed by the Council, before the same shall be effective; and upon being confirmed by the council they shall

/enter upon and assume all the duties of the office of a commissioner of the said Boardas herein provided

SECTION 4- The Park Commission of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, shall have full and complete charge of all public parks, play grounds and other public places of amusement in the said City, and shall have charge of all funds for the improvement of the said parks and public places and the same shall be expended only under the direction of the said Park Board, The said Park board may make such rules and regulation for the government of the said parks and play grounds as they may deem proper.

budget for such funds as they deem proper to be assaxwaxexpended by the city for Park and playgroundpurposes, and such funds shall be available from time to time for the use of the said park board, and the same shall be paid over to the said park board by the treasurer of the City of bebanon from time to time. The said Park Board shall have no authority to bind the city for any contract or for the payment of any money, and the City of Lebanon shall not be liable to the said Park Board to any amount beyond that which it provides in the annual budget.

SECTION 6- The said Park Board may raise funds for its own use in any manner that I may deem proper, either by donations, subscription, s, gifts, bequests, devices of otherwise, or by giving entertainments or amusements, and such funds shall be the funds of the park Board as such and expended under its directions for park purposes, but no funds provided by the budget or by gifts, or by any other manner for the said Park Board, shall be expended for any other purpose thanfor the maintenance and improvement of the said Parks and play grounds of the said City and for equipments for the same, or for buildings thereon.
