

1 ORDINANCE BILL NO. 6 FOR 1920.

2 ORDINANCE NO. 257

3 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CHANGE IN THE PLANS AND SPECIFICA-
4 TIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE OVER THE LEBANON & SANTIAM
5 CANAL ON SOUTH MAIN STREET IN LEBANON, OREGON, AND APPROPRIATING
6 MONEY FOR PAYMENT OF SAME? AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 223.

7 WHEREAS, On the 17th day of September 1818, the council of
8 the city of Lebanon duly passed and enacting Ordinance No. 223
9 providing for the construction of the bridge over the Lebanon
10 and Santiam Canal on the South Main Street in the City of Lebanon
11 and appropriating money therefor, And

12 WHEREAS, the Council thereafter deemed it best not to construct
13 the said bridge at that time, and wheeas as conditions have
14 arisen which makesin necessary and desirable to change the plans
15 and specifications of the said proposed bridge, and

16 Whereas, the bridge now over the said canal on said street is
17 in a bad and dangerous condition from old age and decay and the
18 safety to the public is endangered thereby, and it is urgent
19 and necessary that the said bridge be rebuilt as soon as can
20 reasonable be done. Now therefore.

21 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

22 Section 1. That the Superintendent, of Streets, the City Engineer
23 and the Commistee of Streets and Public Property of the City of
24 Lebanon, Oregon, be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and
25 directed to cause to be constructed and built a concrete bridge
26 over the said Lebanon and Santiam Canal ~~xxxx~~ on South Main streett
27 in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, the same to cost not to exceed
28 \$2000.00, and that the same be built and constructed according
29 to the plans and specifications therefor prepared and submitted
30 by the State Highway Commission of the State of Oregon, which
31 said plans and specification were filed with the Recorder of the
32 City of Lebanon, Oregon, on the 2nd day of March, 1920.

Section 2: That the said plans and specification so filed be

1 substituted and adopted instead of and for the former plans
2 so filed August 20th, 1918. and that the Ordinance No. 223
3 adopted by the Council on the 17th day of September 1918 authoriz-
4 ing the construction of the said bridge, in so far as the same
5 is in conflict with this Ordinance be and the same is hereby
6 repealed. But all work done and performed and material purchased
7 under the said ordinance No. 223 is hereby ratified and approved
8 and hereby made a part of the construction of the said proposed
9 bridge.

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11 Section 3. That there is hereby appropriated out of the gener-
12 al funds of the said City the sum of \$2000.00 or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary for that purpose, to pay for the material and
14 labor and cost of the construction of the said Concrete bridge,
15 which said sum shall include the sums already paid and expended
16 therefor. That the itemized bills for same shall be prepared
17 and submitted to the Council and audited and allowed as other
18 bills and claims against the said City of Lebanon, and paid
19 by the warrants of the said city as other bills are paid.

20 SECTION 4- That the said Street Superintendent and Engineer and
21 said Committee on Streets and Public Property are hereby empower-
22 ed to employ all labor and procure all materials necessary for
23 the construction of the said bridge in accordance with the
24 said plans and specifications, but not to exceed the said sum of
25 \$2000.00 including all sums already expended therefor..

26 SECTION 5- That in as much as the said bridge should be built
27 with as little delay as possible, and the bridge now over the
28 said canal is unsafe for the heavy traffic over said street and
29 bridge, the peace, health and safety requires that this ordi-
30 nance shall be in effect at once, and emergency is hereby de-
31 clared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and
32 effect from and after its passage by the Council and its ap-
33 proved by the mayor.

1 Passed by the Council this 16th day of March, 1920, all mem-
2 bers elected to the Council voting in favor of the adoption of
3 the ordinance on a roll call and the vote taken by aye and nay
4 vote and entered in the journal of the council proceedings.

5 Approved by the Mayor this 16th day of March, 1920
