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   AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CHANGE IN THE PLANS AND SPECIFICA-
   TIONS FOR THE CONSTRCTION OF A BRIDGE OVER THE LEBANON & SANTIAM
   CANAL ON SOUTH MAIN STREET IN LEBANON, CREGON, AND APPROPRIATING
   MONEY FOR PAYMENT OF SAME? AND REPEALING ORDIANCE NO. 223.
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     WHEREAS, On the 17th day of September 1818, the council of
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   the city of Lebanon duly passed and enacting Ordinance No. 223
   providing for the construction of the bridge over the Lebanon
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   and Santiam Canal on the South Main Street in the City of Lebanon
   and appropriating money therefor,
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   WHEREAS, the Council thereafter deemed it best not to construct
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   the said bridge at that time, and wheeas as conditions have
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   arisen which makesin necessary and desirable to change the plans
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   and specifications of the said proposed bridge, and
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   Whereas, the bridge now over the said canal on said street is
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    in a bad and dangerous condition from old age and decay and the
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    safety to the public is endangered thereby, and it is urgent
   and necessary that the said bridge be rebuilt as soon as can
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    reasonable be done. Now therefore.
   THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
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   Section 1. That the Superintendent, of Streets, the City Engineer
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   and the Commistee of Streets and Public Property of the City of
   Lebanon, Oregon, be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and
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    directed to cause to be constructed and built a concrete bridge
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    over the said Lebanon and Santiam Canal wer on South Main street
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    in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, the same to cost not to exceed
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    $2000.00, and that the same be built and constructed according
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    to the plans and specifications therefor prepared and submitted
    by the State Highway Commission of the State of Oregon, which
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    said plans and specification were filed with the Recorder of the
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    City of Lebanon, Oregon, on the 2nd day of March, 1920.
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That the said plans and specification so filed be

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       substituted and adopted instead of and for the former plans
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       so filed August 20th ,1918. and that the Ordinance No. 223
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       adopted by the Council on the 17th day of Se tember1918 authoriz-
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       ing the construction of the said bridge, in so far as the same
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       is in conflict with this Ordinance be and the same is hereby
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       repealed. But all work done and performed and material purchased
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       under the said ordinance No. 223 is hereby ratified and approved
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       and hereby made a part of the construction of the said proposed
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       bridge.
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       Section 3. That there is hereby appropriated out of the gener-
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       al funds of the said City the sum of $2000.00 or so much thereof
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       as may be necessary for that purpose, to pay for the material and
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       labor and cost of the construction of the said Concrete bridge,
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       which said sum shall include the sums already paid and expended
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       therefor. That the itemized bills for same shall be prepared
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       and submitted to the Council and audited and allowed as other
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       bills and claims against the said City of Lebanon, and paid
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       by the warrants of the said city as other bills are paid.
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       SECTION 4_ That the said Street Superintendent and Engineer and
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       said Committee on Streets and Public Property are hereby empower-
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       ed to employ all labor and procure all materials necessary for
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       the construction of the said bridge in accordance with the
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        said plans and specifications, but not to exceed the said sum of
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       $2000.00 including all sums already expended therefor ...
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        SECTION 5- That in as much as the said bridge should be built
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        with as little delay as possible, and the bridge now over the
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        said canal is unsafe for the heavy traffic over said street and
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       bridge, the peace, health and safety requires that this ordi-
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       nance shall be in effect at once, and emergency is hereby de-
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        clared to exist and this ordiance shall be in full force and
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        effect from and after its passage by the Council and its ap-
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povedl by the mayor.

Passed by the Council this 16th day of March, 1920, all mem-bers elected to the Council vot ng in favor of the adoption of the ordiance on a roll call and the vate taken by aye and nay vote and entered in the journal of the council proceedings. Approved by the Mayor this 16th day of March, 1920 Byron Millsafo
