

ORDINANCE NO. 282

An Ordinance to prevent the sale of impure milk for food consumption in the city of Lebanon, Oregon, and providing that all cows furnishing milk in Lebanon for food consumption shall be tubercular tested.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person at any time to sell or offer for sale for food consumption in the City of Lebanon, Oregon any milk from any cow or cows which are sick or ill, or which said milk for any reason is not fit for food consumption; or to sell or offer for sale within the city of Lebanon, Oregon, for food consumption any milk drawn from any cow with a spoiled or diseased bag or udder, or suffering from tuberculosis.

SECTION 2. All cows from which milk is sold or offered for sale within the city of Lebanon, Oregon, for food consumption within the said city of Lebanon, shall be thoroughly tuberculin tested by a regularly licensed veterinarian of the State of Oregon, before any milk drawn from such cows are sold or offered for sale within the said city, for food consumption within the said city.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful from and after the 1st day of March 1922 for any person, firm, co-partnership or corporation, to sell or offer for sale, for food consumption within the city of Lebanon, Oregon any milk drawn from any cow which has not been tuberculin tested as provided in Section 2 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. That inasmuch as the city of Lebanon has no ordinance covering the ~~milk~~ matters in this ordinance, and the health of the city requires that this ordinance becomes a law at once an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council this 7th day of February, 1922, by aye and nay vote of the council more than three fourths of all members elected to the council voting in favor of the ordinance, and the vote entered in the journal proceedings of the council.

Approved by the Mayor this 7th day of February, 1922.
