An Ordinance to license and regulate the use of Gasoline Pumps and gasoline stations in the streets of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. From and after the first day of April, 1922, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, co-partnership or corporation to use, maintain or have any gasoline pump or gasoline stations in or on any street in the city of Lebanon, with out first procuring a permit therefor and pay the license fees therefor as herein provided.

SECTION 2. Before any gasoline pump shall be used and kept or maintained in or on any street of the city of Lebanon, from and after the first day of April, 1922, the owner, proprietor or his agent or employee shall, at which or from which gasoline is sold or may be sold, shall procure from the recorder of the city of Lebanon a permit for same, which said permit shall describe the place and location, of the said pump, All application for a permit shall be accompanied by an application for such permit, and have endorsed thereon the approval of the committee on streets and public property of the Common council of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, or an order of its approval by the council as a whole.

SECTION 3. Upon the presenting to the recorder of such application for a permit to establish or maintain a gasoline pump in or on any street of the city of Lebanon, with the endorsement thereon of the said committee of its approval, or the order of the council approving same, the recorder shall upon the payment to him of the fees as herein provided issue to such applicant a permit to establish or maintain such pump in the place and manner described in said application or order or approval.

SECTION 4. All applicants for any permit to establish or maintain any gasoline pump in any street of the city of Lebanon shall pay an annual license for each so to be established or maintained the sum of \$12.00, the said sum to be paid quarterly, semi-annually or annually in advance, at the rate of \$3.00 per quarter or six dollars for six months and \$12.00 for one year. No permit or license shall be granted for a longer term or period than one year or shorter than three months.

SECTION 5. All gasoline pumps now in the streets of the City of Lebanon, or those that may hereafter be placed in or on any street of the said city, on which the license is not paid on or before the first day of April, 1922, shall be removed from the said street within ten days from the said first day of April, 1922, and the street or sidewalk put in as soon condition as the same was before the said pump was established or put in, and to the satisfaction of the street superintendent and the said committee on streets and public property, of the said city.

SECTION 6. Any person, or persons, firm, corporation or co-partnership violating any of the provisions of this ordinance or maintaining or using or keeping any gasoline pump in any street of the city of Lebanon, without first complying with all the terms and provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the recorders court, be punished by a fine not exceeding the sum of One Hundred Dollars or by imprisonment in the city fail not exceeding fifty days.

SECTION 7. All gasoline pumps in or on any street of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, upon which a permit is not taken out as herein provided and the license fee therefor paid on or before the 1st day of April, 1922, and which have not been removed from the said street within ten days after April, 1st, 1922, shall immediately thereafter be removed from the said street by the Marshal of the city of Lebanon, Tregon, and the expenses and charges of removing the same shall be charbed against the said pump so removed, and the marshal shall hold the said pump until the same is fully paid, and if the same shall not be paid within ten days thereafter, the said marshal shall sell the said pump at public sale as upon execution, and apply the proceeds from such sale to pay the costs and charges of removing the same including the expenses of such sale, and the repair of the said street and side walk.
