ORDINANCE NO. 285

AM ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING OREGON AND CALIFORNIA RAILROAD COMPANY, ITS SUCCESSORS? LESSEES AND ASSIGSN, TO C NSTRUCT, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN AN INDUSTRY SPUR TRACK UPON AND ACROSS ROSE STREET A SHORT DISTANCE WE T OF THE INTERSECTION OF THIRD STREET WITH ROSE STREET IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That OREGON AND CALIFORNIA RAILEOAD COMPANY, an Oregon Corporation, its successors, lessees and assigns, is hereby granted the perpetual privilege, right and franchise to construct, maintain and operate an industrial spur track upon and across Rose Street a short distance west of the intersection of Third Street with Rose Street in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, the center line of which said industrial spur track is described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north line of Rose Street, about 342 ft. west of the west line of 3rd Street and running in a southerly direction across Rose Street to a point in the south line thereof, which point is approximately 45 feet west of the west line of 3rd Street."

SECTION 2. Said grantee, its successors, lessees and assigns, is hereby granted the right to make the necessary excavations for the construction of said industry spur track, provided, however, that said street between the rails of said track, and for a distance of eighteen inches outside thereof, shall be maintained by said grantee in such condition as will not unnecessaily interfere with the use thereof by the traveling public, and, provided further, that in the event of the hard surfacing of the adjacent portion of said street the grantee shall improve all of said industrial spur track with planking or rock or pave with same materials as street is paved if so ordered, between the rails and for eighteen inches outside thereof, such surfacing to be level with the top rail of said industry spur track.

SECTION 3. The construction of said industry spur track by said grantee, its successors, lessees and assigns, shall be deemed an acceptance of the franchise hereby granted subject to all the terms and conditions in this ordinance set forth.
