

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE.

Ord bill # 1

Ordinance No. 296

An Ordinance authorizing the payment for certain
lumber furnished to the City of Lebanon by R.
E. King.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That whereas the Street Superin-
tendent has been duly authorized, by the City Council,
to construct a bridge across the Lebanon and Santiam
Canal on Hiatt Street between Grant and Sherman Streets
and to order the necessary material therefor, and

WHEREAS, the said superintendent, in compli-
ance with said order, ordered certain lumber from R. E.
King which said R. E. King delivered to the City of
Lebanon and which said lumber cost the sum of \$142.00
delivered at the site of said bridge.

THEREFORE, the Mayor and Recorder are hereby
authorized to draw a warrant upon the Street Fund or
other funds of the City for the sum of \$142.^{1.36}~~00~~ in favor
of the said R. E. King. for the payment of said lumber.
