

Ordinance bill # 3 - ORDINANCE NO. 297  
1923

An ordinance to vacate the alley running North and South through the center of Block One in William Ralston's Addition to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, State of Oregon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Whereas a petition has been presented to the City Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, asking that the alley running North and South through the center of Block One of William Ralston's Addition to Lebanon, Oregon, be vacated, and whereas due and timely notice has been given of the hearing of said petition as by law required, and proof thereof is on file with the recorder of said City, and no one appearing in opposition to said petition, and it further appearing that all persons interested in said petition and being owners of the land adjacent to said alley gave their consent in writing which consent is embodied in said petition, and it further appearing that the law providing for the vacation of streets and alleys of incorporated Cities has been fully complied with,

Therefore it is hereby considered, ordered and adjudged that the alley running north and south through the center of block one in William Ralston's addition to the city of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
