

Ordinance bill No 11 for 1923.

Ordinance No 305.

A BILL

For an ordinance creating a special fund for the building of the bridge across the canal on South Second street and appropriating money therefor out of any sum in the City Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. There is hereby created a special fund to be known "South Second Street as the bridge fund" for the purpose of purchasing materials and erecting a bridge across the canal on South Second Street in Lebanon, Oregon.

Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated, out of the money or funds in the City Treasury the sum of Three Hundred Dollars, not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying for the materials, and labor in constructing the ^{said} bridge across the canal on South Second Street.

Passed by the Council this 9th day of November, 1923.
