A BILL FOR

An ordinance directing the payment of One Hundred Three and 50/100 Dollars to Linn County and the sum of One Hundred Sixty-two and 72/100 Dollars to Clarence Ingram.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the County of Linn did certain work on the streets of the City of Lebanon at the request of the Superintendent of Streets in scarifying and grading the streets of the City of Lebanon, and Whereas, ^{Green Mt Lumber Co} Clarence Ingram furnished certain lumber to the said City of Lebanon at the request of the Superintendent of Streets for the building and repairing of bridges in the said City.

THEREFORE, the City Recorder is hereby instructed to draw a warrant in favor of said County of Linn for the sum of One Hundred Three and 50/100 Dollars and in favor of Clarence Ingram for the sum of One Hundred Sixty-two and 72/100 Dollars.
