

ORDINANCE NO 18 FOR 1923.

Ordinance No 307

A BILL

for an ordinance directing the payment to M.D. Shanks of the sum of \$500.00 to re-imburse him for money paid for the settlement of the case of the City of Lebanon vs Elizabeth McCormick et al for condemnation of land.

The people of the city of Lebanon, do ordain as follows:

Whereas the City of Lebanon commenced an action to condemn certain real property belonging to the defendants in the case wherein the said City was plaintiff and Elizabeth McCormick et al were defendants, and whereas a settlement has been entered into whereby the said City is to pay the sum of \$500.00 as damages for the right of way over and across the lands of the defendants in said action, ^{and 600 cu. yds. of Earth} and whereas the said M.D. Shanks as City Attorney has paid the said sum to the said defendants,

Therefore the City recorder is hereby directed and ordered to ~~draw~~ a warrant in favor of the said M.D. Shanks and against the Dike fund for the said sum of \$500.00/
