A BILL

For an Ordinance levying an assessment against all the taxable property of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, for the year 1924.

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Council, acting with six freeholders chosen from the various wards of the City, prepared an estimate or budget of all money necessary to be raised by taxation for the year 1924, and

WHEREAS, a date was set for the hearing of said budget by the taxpayers of said city, and whereas, after said hearing, said budget or estimate of the amount of money to be raised was submitted to the Tax Supervising Commission of Linn County, Oregon, as by law required, and whereas, said Tax Supervising Commission has approved said budget in the following manner, to-wit:

It is estimated that revenues from sources other than taxation will accrue to the City of Lebanon in the year 1924 in the amount of Six Hundred Ten Dollars (\$610.00).

THEREFORE, there is hereby levied against all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, a total tax amounting to \$22050.00 for the year 1924.
