An ordinance providing for the purchase/and payment for one
two-horse maintenance Russell Grader.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO

ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Whereas by agreement with the Council of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, the Russell Company, of Portland, Oregon, shipped to the City of Lebanon, for thirty days trial one Russell two-horse maintenance grader, which if satisfactory to said City after fair trial, the said City was to purchase, and whereas after careful trial the street committee and street superintendent of said City are well satisfied with the same, and whereas the said City is in need of such a grader, therefore the Recorder of the City of Lebanon is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant upon the general fund of the City for the sum of \$248.63 in payment of said Grader.

Section 2. In as much as the streets of said city of Lebanon are greatly in need of repair and some of them are in a dangerous condition, and the said City has no suitable grader with which to repair them, other than the one above referred to, and in as much as it is necessary for the protection of the public safety of the City of Lebanon that said streets be repaired and kept in a safe condition, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
