

ORDINANCE BILL NO. ¹⁵ FOR 1924.

Ordinance no. 319

A BILL FOR

An Ordinance levying an assessment against all the taxable property of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, for the year 1925

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, on the day of September, 1924, the Council, acting with six freeholders chosen from the various wards of the city, prepared an estimate or budget of all money necessary to be raised by taxation for the year 1925, for the purpose of conducting the business of the city for the year 1925.

WHEREAS, Wednesday, November 5th, 1924, was set for the hearing of said budget by the taxpayers of said city, and whereas a hearing was duly had at the city council chambers on said date, and whereas, at said hearing no objection was raised to the tentative budget, which said tentative budget was adopted in the following amounts:

Personal Service - City Officers	\$ 4425.00
Recorder's Office - Water Rent & Supplies	1706.00
Treasurer's Office- Bond and Supplies	55.00
Legal Department - Supplies	20.00
Health Department	50.00
Street Repairs & Supplies	5700.00
Police Department - Supplies	26.00
Public Library - Support	300.00
Fire Department - supplies	1235.00
Miscellaneous Fund - All Departments	500.00
Fixed Charges	9920.00
TOTAL	<u>\$23937.00</u>

It is estimated that revenues from sources other than taxation will accrue to the city of Lebanon in the year 1925 in the amount of Six hundred seventy Dollars (\$670.00).

THEREFORE, there is hereby levied against all taxable property within the corporate limits of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, a total tax amounting to \$23267.00 for the year 1925.
