

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE No. 1 for 1925

ORDINANCE NO. 321

An ordinance authorizing the payment to Linn County of the sum of \$291.00 for 388 yards of crushed rock.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.- Whereas the superintendent of streets of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, by direction of the City Council, and for the purpose of improving certain streets within the City of Lebanon, Oregon, purchased from the County of Linn, State of Oregon 388 yards of Crushed gravel, and whereas the said County has presented a bill therefor in the sum of \$291.00, now therefore the City recorder is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant in favor of the said county for said sum of \$291.00 in payment of said crushed gravel, and mail the same to the County Clerk of said County.
