

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 7 FOR 1925.

Ordinance No. 327

A BILL FOR

An ordinance amending Sections 1 and 4 of Ordinance No. 237 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, passed by the Council on the 20th day of May, 1919, and approved by the Mayor on the 20th day of May, 1919.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 237 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1: That no public dance shall be held within the corporate limits of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, without the proprietor, manager or agent or other person or persons promoting said dance first applying in writing to the license committee of the Common Council of the said city of Lebanon for and obtaining a permit to give such dance, for which permit such person or persons shall pay a fee of Five Dollars.

Section 2: Section 4 of Ordinance No. 237 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4: The public ^{DANCE} as defined by this ordinance shall be any dance given where the public is invited or permitted to attend and where an admission fee is charged or where a fee is charged or exacted from any person to dance at ^{such} dance or where a voluntary contribution is paid by any person for the privilege of dancing or attending such dance or where any money is raised by any means to defray the expenses of such dance. This ordinance shall not apply to any private dance given or held in a private home or to one given by a Club or organization or lodge where no fee is charged for dancing and where no fee is charged for admittance to such dance.

Section 3: In as much as the present ordinance regulating dances and dance halls within the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, is in-

adequate for the proper supervision of said dances and in as much as the peace, quiet, health and safety of the City of Lebanon requires that this ordinance be in effect with as little delay as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

PASSED by the Council this 21st day of April, 1925, by unanimous vote of the Council upon roll call and the vote entered in the Journal of the Council.

APPROVED by the Mayor this 21st day of April, 1925.
