

ORDINANCE BILL NO. ¹⁰ 11 FOR 1925.

ORDINANCE NO. 330

A BILL FOR

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, to enter into a contract with

Guy F. Pyle

for the improvement of Main Street from the South line of Carolina Street North to the North City Limits of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, by ordinance No. 328 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, it was ordered that Main Street from the South line of Carolina Street North to the North city limits of said city be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

1. By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
2. By paving said street full width from the South line of Carolina Street to the North line of Academy Street and twenty feet wide from the North line of Academy Street North to the North City Limits, said twenty foot strip to be as near the center as practicable, the same to be paved with either:
 - (a) Portland cement concrete pavement 6" thick;
 - (b) Portland cement concrete pavement 7" thick;
 - (c) Asphaltic concrete pavement, 2" top, 4" crushed rock base;
 - (d) Warrenite-Bitulithic, 2" top, 4" crushed rock base;
 - (e) Warrenite-Bitulithic, 1½" top, 2½" Bituminous base;
 - (f) Warrenite-Bitulithic, 1½" top, 3½" Bituminous base.
3. By paving headers.
4. By constructing inlets.

5. By laying vitrified sewer pipes.

6. By tapping sewers.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of Engineer K. A. Sinclair, then on file with the Recorder of said City of Lebanon; and

WHEREAS, it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, after due notice and advertisement for bids, made and given by the Recorder of the City of Lebanon according to law and the ordinance last aforesaid, to-wit: on the 24th day of June, 1925, Guy F. Pyle

presented to the Council of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, his bid for making said improvement with Warrenite-Bitulithic 1½" top 3½" Bituminous base, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and required by the Council, by which said bid Guy F. Pyle

proposed to furnish all material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement with Warrenite-Bitulithic 1½" top 3½" Bituminous base

for the following named prices, to-wit:

sum equal to the amount of the bid of the said contractor, to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, having as surety some Surety Company authorized to do business in the State of Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of Guy F. Pyle

_____ and further indemnifying the City of Lebanon against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation arising out of said contract.

Section 3: WHEREAS, it is necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, that the foregoing described improvement be immediately constructed and therefore an emergency exists and one is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full, force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
