

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 36 FOR 1925.

Ordinance No. 349

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE Authorizing and directing the the issuance of improvement bonds of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, for the improvement of Second Street from the South line of Grant Street to the North line of Tangent Street in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and to repeal all that part of Ordinance No. 342 in conflict herewith.

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of October, 1925, the Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, duly passed Ordinance No. 342 providing, among other things, for the issuance and sale of improvement bonds of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, for the improvement of Second Street from the South line of Grant Street to the North line of Tangent Street in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, which said Ordinance was, on said date, duly approved by the Mayor of said City and attested by the Recorder; and

WHEREAS, by said ordinance, the said Council authorized the issuance and sale of bonds for said improvement in the sum of \$15,202.16 and whereas applications for bonding of said improvement were on file with the City Recorder, and are now on file with the City Recorder, for only the sum of \$14,968.29; and

WHEREAS, applications above mentioned for \$14,968.29 are separate and are each now on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and each application has been duly entered in the Bond Lien Docket in the City of Lebanon; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of unpaid assessment for said improvement of said street for which applications to pay under the provisions of the said Act above referred to, as shown by said Bond Lien Docket, is the sum of \$14,968.29.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Lebanon, Oregon are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to sign, execute and deliver on behalf of the said City of Lebanon its negotiable interest bearing coupon bonds and issue its said bonds in all equal to the amount of \$14,968.29, the said sum being the total amount of the unpaid assessments for such street improvement of the said street for which applications to pay under the provisions of Chapter 15 of Title 27, Oregon Laws, have been filed with the Recorder of said City, as shown by the Bond Lien Docket of the said City, which said bonds shall be numbered from one to thirty, both inclusive, and shall be in denominations of \$500.00 each, except the bond bearing the No. Thirty, it being the highest number of said bond and shall be for the sum of \$468.29.

Section 2: That in all other respects, said bonds shall conform with the provisions of said ordinance No. 342, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor, as herein before stated.

Section 3: That all that part of said ordinance No. 342 in conflict herewith be and the same is hereby repealed.
