

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 1 FOR 1926.

Ordinance No. 350

An ordinance to amend Section 47 of ordinance No. 276 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 47 of ordinance No. 276 of the city of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 47. No person shall within limits of Lebanon, Oregon, place or maintain, or cause to be placed or maintained or suffer the same to be maintained, upon or over any street or sidewalk of said city in front of or adjacent to any building, structure or premises therein, or otherwise, any sign, advertisement, flag, or banner or other contrivance, except on holidays, festival days, election days and days of public parades; provided that the Chautauqua occasions and strawberry festivals banner or flags may be used for display and advertising purposes over the streets, provided that they are placed securely and not less than fifteen feet above the street level. And provided further that electric signs may be hung over the sidewalks in front of buildings and as far out as the curbline in front of the building and no further, and the bottom of said signs shall not be less than nine feet above the level of the sidewalk over which they are placed. Other signs may be hung over the sidewalks in front of the buildings as far out as four feet from the property line; provided that the height of the bottom of such sign shall not be less than eight feet above the sidewalk over which it is hung. No sign shall be hung from a post or posts except the post or posts be constructed of

concrete or iron or of either iron or concrete and veneered with brick, which post or posts shall be of sufficient strength and embedded in the ground to a sufficient depth to support said sign so that the same may not be dangerous to the public and shall be approved by the Street Superintendent and City Engineer before use thereof is permitted. Such post or posts must be located inside the property line. All signs not fastened to posts constructed as above provided shall be securely bolted or fastened to the building to which they are attached and all such signs not so securely fastened or bolted to such posts or to the building to which they are attached, shall be taken down and removed or made secure.
