

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 3 FOR 1926.

Ordinance No. 351

An ordinance to amend Section 5 of Ordinance No. 246 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, passed by the Council on the 5th day of December, 1919, and approved by the Mayor on the same date.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 5 of ordinance No. 246 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, passed by the Council on the 5th day of December, 1919, and approved by the Mayor on the same date, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 5: All flues hereafter built in the city of Lebanon shall be built from the ground or on wood or frame supports or brackets securely built so that the flue shall not settle, and if built upon brackets or frame the same shall be at least three feet below the ceiling and the bottom of the opening for stove pipes shall be at least six inches above the bottom of the brick and the pipe at least two foot below the ceiling. No frame work of the building which is concealed shall be within less distance than one and a half inches from the brick wall of the flue or chimney. All flues and chimneys of whatever material built shall extend at least three feet above the roof to be measured from the upper side of the flue or chimney where it passed through the roof.
