

Ordinance Bill No. 7 for 1927.

Ordinance No. 364.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

to amend section 11 of Ordinance No. 33 of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, passed by the Council on the 23rd day of February, 1924, and approved by the Mayor on said date, relating to minors being abroad or upon the streets of said City after certain hours, and providing a penalty.

SECTION 1. Section 11 of ordinance No. 33 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, is hereby amended to read as follows:  
Section 11.- That no minor under sixteen years of age shall be permit to go abroad upon or wander about upon or be upon any street, alley or in any other public place in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, after the hour of 9:30 o'clock P.M. at night during the months of April, May, June, July, August and September, and after ~~the hour of 9:00 o'clock P.M.~~ <sup>the hour of 9:00 o'clock P.M.</sup> at night during the months of October, November, December, January, February and March, unless such minor shall be accompanied by a parent, guardian, or other person of legal age lawfully in charge of such minor, or unless such minor shall have necessary business upon such street, alley, or other public place. Any minor under sixteen years of age who shall violate any or all of the provisions of this section of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court, be fined not more than fifty Dollars, or be imprisoned in the City jail not more than twenty-five days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the Recorder.
