

Ordinance Bill No. 10 for 1927.

Ordinance No. 366.

A bill for an ordinance levying an assessment against all the taxable property in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon for the year 1928.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1927, the Common Council acting with six free holders chosen from the several wards of the City as by law required, prepared an estimate or budget of all money necessary to be raised by taxation for the year 1928 for the purpose of conducting the business of the said City of Lebanon for the year 1928; and

Whereas Monday, November 14, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. was set for the hearing of said budget, and whereas notice of such hearing was duly and regularly given in all respects as by law required, and said notice was on said date and at the time and place in said notice specified, duly and regularly held; and

Whereas, a full and complete hearing was had upon said tentative budget, and the council being the levying board of the City of Lebanon, being now fully advised as to the amount necessary to be raised by taxation for all purposes of said City for the year 1928, which said amounts are as follows:

Personal Service-City officers.....	\$5,045.00
Recorder's office-water, rent, supplies	1,896.00
Treasurer's office- bond and supplies	45.00
Legal department, supplies & incidentals	20.00
Health department	50.00
Police department-Telephone, telegraph & meals	20.00
Streets and public works	3,500.00
Street lights, repairs etc	2,700.00
Public library	300.00
Contingent fund	1,350.00
Fire Department	1,216.00
Fixed charges	11,030.00
Total amount to be raised from all sources	27,172.00
Amount estimated to be raised from fines	900.00
Amount to be raised by taxation	\$26,272.00



Now therefore, there is hereby levied against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, a total tax amounting to the sum of \$26,272.00 for the year 1928.

Passed by the Council this 15th day of November, 1927.
