

Ordinance Bill No. 11 for 1927.

Ordinance No. 367.

A BILL

for an ordinance appropriating the sum of not to exceed  
\$5000<sup>00</sup> for the construction of a city building.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the  
general fund or any other available fund of the City of Lebanon  
a sum not in excess of \$5000<sup>00</sup> as may be necessary for  
the payment of the contract price of the City building Author-  
ized by the Council to be erected on Lot 5 Block 1, Ralston's  
Third Addition to Lebanon, Oregon.
