

ORDINANCE BILL NO 12 FOR 1927.

ORDINANCE NO 368.

A BILL

For an ordinance designating certain streets within the corporate limits of Lebanon, Oregon, as through streets; providing for posting "stop" signs at entrances thereto from intersecting streets; providing for the regulation of vehicles entering such streets from intersecting streets; and providing a penalty for violation of this ordinance.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following streets or parts of streets, within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, are hereby designated as "Through Streets", to-wit:

Main Street from the North line of Wheeler^{St.} to the South City Limits of Lebanon.

Grant Street from the East line of Main Street to the East line of Hiatt Street.

Sherman Street from the West line of Main Street to the West line of Third Street.

Section 2. There shall be erected at the entrances to such Through Streets from intersecting streets a suitable sign, so placed as to be easily seen by the driver of an approaching vehicle, which said sign shall have on it, among other things which it may contain, the word "STOP" in bold faced letters, not less than 4 inches in height.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to enter any of said designated Through Streets from an intersecting street which has been posted as provided in section 2 hereof, without first bring^{ing} such vehicle to a full stop.

Section 4. All police or traffic officers, and sheriffs, when in pursuit of their official duties, and all firemen when traveling in response to a fire alarm, and public or

private ambulances; and also the driver of any vehicle while travelling in a regular funeral procession are hereby exempted from the provisions of this ordinance. Provided, however, that the exemption herein contained shall not protect the driver of any such vehicle from the consequences of a reckless disregard of the safety of others.

Section 5. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder, be fined not to exceed Ten Dollars, which fine shall be collected as other fines.
