

Ordinance Bill No. 1 for 1928.

Ordinance No. 371.

A BILL for an ordinance to amend Section 2, of Ordinance No. 213, entitled "an ordinance to regulate and license the selling of cigarettes, cigarette wrappers and cigarette paper in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and to punish any violation of this ordinance".

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That section 2 of ordinance No. 213 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Any person, persons, company, association, or corporation, selling cigarettes, cigarette wrapping paper, or cigarette papers or any other thing or material used in the making of cigarettes, shall pay an annual license of Thirty Dollars, which said license shall be payable in advance on the first day of January each year, as other licenses are paid, and shall expires on the 31st day of December following; and no license shall issue for less than the annual fee.
