Ordinance No. 370

A Bill

for an ordinance designating certain street intersections where reverse truns shall not be made; providing for erection of suitable signs thereat; and providing a menalty, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEGAL ON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: Section 1. Hereafter it shall be unlawful for any vehicle, whether horse drawn or propelled by motor or otherwise, to make any reverse turn at any of the following street intersections within the City of Lebanon, Oregon, to-wit:

- 1- The Intersection of Main and Sherman Sts.
- 2. The intersection of lain and Grant Streets.

Section 2. The Superintendent of Streets and Public Property shall cause suitable signs to be placed at each of the above named intersections to advise the public against reverse turns.

Section 3. Any person convicted of the violation of this ordiance shall be subject to a fine of not to exceed \$10.00.

section 4. In as much as it is dangerous to the safety of the general public to make reverse turns at any of the above intersections, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the erection of the signs hereinabove provided for.
