Ordinance Bill No. 372

A Bill for an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 97 passed by the Council on the 5th day of May, 1910 and approved by the Mayor on the 8th day of May, 1910, entitled "An ordinance to establish a curb line on the Streets of Lebanon, and to provide the manner ~~and~~ of construction of curbs"and to repeal all ordinances in conflict herewith:

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. That section 1 of ordinance no. 97 passed by the Council on the 5th day of May, 1910 and approved by the Mayor on the 8th day of May, 1910, entitled An ordinance to provide the manner of constructing of Curbs, and to repeal all ordinances in conflict therewith,; be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That all curbs put in or built on Main Street from B. Street South to the South line of the City limits shall be built 10 feet out in the Street from the property line abutting on said Street.

Passed by the Council this 20th day of March, 1928.
