

Ordinance Bill No. 11 for 1928.

Ordinance NO 379.

A bill for an ordinance levying an assessment against the taxable property of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, for the year 1929.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Whereas on the 16th day of October, 1928, the common Council acting with six free holders chosen from the several wards of the City, met, as by law required, and prepared an estimate of all the money necessary to be raised by taxation for the year 1929, for the purpose of conducting the business of the City of Lebanon for the year 1929, and

WHEREAS, Monday, November 19, at the hour of 8:00 P.M. was duly set for the hearing on said budget or estimate, and whereas notice of such hearing was duly and regularly given in all respects as by law required, and said meeting was on said date and at the time and place in said notice specified, duly and regularly held, and

WHEREAS a full and complete hearing was had upon said tentative budget or estimate of costs, and the Council being the levying board of the said City, being now fully advised as to the amount necessary to be raised by taxation for all purposes of the said City for the year 1929, which said amounts are as follows:
