

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 10 1928.

Ordinance No. 380

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT PART OF MORTON STREET BETWEEN SECOND STREET AND THIRD STREET IN LEBANON, LINN COUNTY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, on the 18 day of September, 1928, John Summers, N. M. Newport and Fred Kerr, constituting the school board for district No. 16, Linn County, Oregon, filed with the recorder of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, a petition asking that all that part of Morton Street lying and being between Second Street and Third Street in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon be vacated, and

WHEREAS, the common council of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, did on the said 18 day of September, 1928, duly pass and enact a resolution fixing as the time and place for hearing the said petition and any remonstrances or objections thereto for the vacation of the said street November 7, 1928, at 3 o'clock P. M. at the council chambers of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, the same being the regular meeting time and place of the said council, and

WHEREAS, the said council did in the said resolution order and require the recorder of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, to give regular notice to all persons concerned of the time and place of the said meeting and hearing, and

WHEREAS, the recorder of the said city has filed with the council and in his office said notices and has done all things required by law and required by the city of Lebanon, Oregon, and there being no remonstrances or objections filed or made and no one appearing or objecting to same or the vacation of the said street and it appearing to the council that after due consideration and investigation the said school district No. 16 of Linn County, Oregon, owns all the abutting land upon the said street petitioned to be vacated and is the only person affected by the vacation thereof and that it is for the best interest of the said city and its inhabitants that the said petition be granted and the said portion of said street be

vacated as asked for in said petition.

NOW THEREFORE, the people of the city of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section One: That all that portion of Morton Street lying and being between Second Street and Third Street in the city of Lebanon, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated and the land therein described become the property of the abutting land of the said school district No. 16 of Linn County, Oregon.

Section Two: This ordinance passed by a unanimous vote of all members elected to the council taken by aye and nay vote on the roll call of the council and the vote entered in the journal of the council this <sup>20<sup>th</sup></sup> day of November, 1928.
