Ordinance No. 10 for 1929,

Ordinance No. 388

A bill for an ordinance vacating all that part of B and C. Streets within the City of Lebanon, Oregon, between Third and Fourth Streets.

WHEREAS Frank Gleason, by a duly verified petition, has petitioned the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, for an order vacating B and C Streets between Third and Fourth Streets of Lebanon, Oregon, and

Whereas due notice of the time and place of hearing of said petition was regularly given as provided by law, and

Whereas Tuesday, July 2, 1929, at the hour of eight o'clock P.M. at the Council Chamber in Lebanon, Oregon was the time and place fixed for the hearing of said petition, and now is the time and this the place set for said hearing, and no objection has been filed and no objector is now appearing to oppose the vacation of said parts of said streets, THEREFORE

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section-1- That those parts of B and C. Streets lying between Third and Fourth Streets in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, be and the same are hereby vacated.
