

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 16 FOR 1929.

ORDINANCE NO. 396.

A BILL for an Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, to enter into a contract with Dan Young for the construction of an eight inch lateral sewer on Elmore Street connecting with the trunk sewer at a point where the same crosses said Elmore Street and running thence Easterly 690 feet, more or less, to the alley in Block 2, Queen Anne Addition to Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Whereas, by ordinance No. 394 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, passed by the Council on the 19th day of November, 1929, it was ordered that an eight inch lateral sewer be laid on Elmore Street connecting with the trunk sewer at a point where the same crosses said Elmore Street and running thence Easterly 690 feet, more or less, to the alley in Block 2 in Queen Anne Addition to Lebanon, Oregon, in the manner following, to-wit:

- (1) To be laid $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet below the street grade.
- (2) To be constructed with eight inch vitrified sewer tile laid with cement mortar; all Ys for residence lot connections to be six inches and for the school building to be eight inches.
- (3) Two manholes with usual cast iron tops.
- (4) Covering tile so that no obstruction will be left in the street.
- (5) All work to be done in ordinary workmanlike manner and said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City, which said plans, specifications and estimates are now on file with the City Recorder of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon; and

Whereas it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, advertise for bids for making said improvement in the manner provided by law; and

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Lebanon, according to law and the ordinances last aforesaid, Dan Young presented to the Council of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, his bid for making said improvement in accordance with the plans, and specifications now on file for said improvement and in accordance with the specifications in said notice, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all conditions imposed by law and required by the Council, by which said bid the said Dan Young proposed to furnish all the materials and implements and perform the labor necessary to construct said sewer according to said plans and specifications and in the manner herein above setout; for the sum of \$775.00; and

Whereas, the said Dan Young was the lowest responsible bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best responsible bid made therefor.

THEREFORE:

Section 1: That the bid of Dan Young for the construction of said sewer be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said Dan Young for the construction of said sewer, for and on behalf of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, upon the terms in said bid herein above mentioned.

Section 2: Said contract to provide further that the work of said improvement shall be entirely completed on or before the 25th day of December, 1929, and that the City of Lebanon, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of Five Dollars a day for each and every day that the work is delayed beyond said 25th day of December, 1929; and that the said Dan Young furnish a bond equal to the amount of his said bid in favor of the

City of Lebanon for the faithful performance of said work, which said bond shall be approved by the Mayor of the City of Lebanon and which said bond shall also indemnify the City of Lebanon against any claim for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation arising out of said contract.

Section 3: Whereas, it is necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, that the foregoing described improvement be immediately constructed and that an emergency therefore exists, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist. Therefore, this ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
