

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 17 FOR 1929.

ORDINANCE NO. 397.

A BILL for an ordinance appropriating money for the construction of an eight inch lateral sewer on Elmore Street in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, connecting with the trunk sewer where the same crosses said Elmore Street and extending Easterly 690 feet to the alley in Block 2, Queen Anne Addition to said City of Lebanon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That there is hereby appropriated, out of any available fund of the City of Lebanon, the sum of \$775.00 for the purpose of the construction of an eight inch lateral sewer on Elmore Street connecting with the trunk sewer where the same crosses said Elmore Street and extending Easterly a distance of 690 feet, more or less, to the alley, in Block 2 of Queen Anne Addition to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon; and the City Recorder is hereby directed to issue a warrant for said sum payable to Dan Young, the person to whom contract for constructing said sewer has been let, when completed, in accordance with the contract.
