ORDINANCE BILL NO. 20 FOR 1929.

ORDINANCE NO. 1/00

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE to regular and license the selling of tobacco and all tobacco products in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon; to punish any violation of this ordinance; to repeal Ordinance No. 213 of the City of Lebanon as amended by Ordinance No. 371 thereof; and declaring an emergency.

IN THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Any person, or persons, company, association or corporation selling tobacco or any tobacco products, including cigars, cigeretts or tobacco in any form, shall pay an annual license to the City of Lebanon in the sum of Ten Dollars, said license to be paid on January 1st of each year and no license shall be issued for less than one year.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any person within the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, to sell or give to any minor, directly or indirectly, any cigerette or cigars or any cigerette paper or cigerette wrappers or any other material used for the making of cigerettes.

Section 3: It shall be unlawful for any person, or persons, company, association or corporation to sell, deal in or give away to any person, directly or indirectly, within the limits of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, any tobacco or tobacco products of any kind, including eigerettes, eigerette wrappers, eigerette papers or any other substance or material used in the making of eigerettes, without having first procured and paid for the license herein above provided.

:Section 4: Any person, or persons, company, association, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the Recorder of the City of Lebanon, be punished by a fine of not Issathan Ton Dollara nor more than One Hundred Dollars; or by imprisonment of not less than five days nor more than fifty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment,

Section 5: Ordinance No. 213 of the City of Lebanon, entitled " An ordinance to regulate and license the selling of cigerettes, cigerette wrappers and cigerette papers in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and to punish any violation of this ordinance", as amended by Ordinance No. 371 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 6: Whereas the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, require that this ordinance be in effect at once, that an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
