

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 38 FOR 1929.

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE providing an occupation license to be paid by any and all persons, firms, associations and corporations engaged in any business, trade, calling, profession, pursuit or occupation of any kind and nature for profit within the corporate limits of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Every person, firm, association or corporation now engaged, or hereafter to engage, in any business, trade, profession, calling, pursuit or occupation shall pay an annual occupation license for the privilege of so engaging in such business, trade, profession, calling, pursuit or occupation within the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, in the sum of \$5.00.

Section 2: Such license shall be payable on the first day of January each year, as all other licenses are paid to the City of Lebanon, and shall be in addition to any and all other licenses or tax heretofore provided.

Section 3: Any person, firm, association or corporation engaging in any such business, trade, profession, calling, pursuit or occupation after June 30th of any year, shall be entitled to one-half year license; and all licenses provided for in this ordinance shall expire on December 31st of the year in which said license is issued.

Section 4: All applications for occupation licenses, under the provision of this ordinance, shall be made to the City Recorder, and, unless objection be made by the license committee

of the City Council to the issuance of such license, the Recorder shall, upon payment of the fee, issue a permit or license for the engaging in and carrying on of such business, trade, profession, calling, pursuit or occupation.

Section 5: It is the intention of this ordinance that only the owner or proprietor of such business, trade, profession, calling, pursuit or occupation shall pay such occupation license and no employee of any such person, firm, association or corporation shall be required to pay such license.

Section 6: Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon require that this ordinance become immediately effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
