ORDINANCE NO. 415

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE KINDS OF MATERIALS TO BE USED IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDE WALKS IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON; DEFINING THE LIMITS OF THE CEMENT SIDE WALK DISTRICT IN THE SAID CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 293, PASSED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 19th DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1922.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The territory embraced and included in the hereinafter described limits of the City of Lebanon shall be designated and known as the cement sidewalk district, and no walks shall be made or laid in said district except made of concrete, or cement, sand, and gravel in the proportions and in the manner now provided by ordinances of the said City for cement or concrete walks, to-wit:

All of Main Street from the North boundary line to the South boundary line of said City of Lebanon; and, also, all of Grant Street from the West boundary line to the East boundary line of said City of Lebanon; and Elmore Street from Main Street East to the West line of ~~Grave~~^{Williams} Street. Also, beginning at the Southwest corner of the intersection of Main and Oak Streets; and running thence West on the South side of Oak Street to the West line of Fifth Street; thence North on the West line of Fifth Street to the North line of Rose Street; thence East on the North line of Rose Street to the West line of Third Street; thence Northwesterly along the West line of Third Street to the North line of Tangent Street; thence East on the North line of Tangent Street to the West line of Second Street; thence North on the West line of Second Street to the North line of Olive Street; thence East on the North line of Olive Street, if extended, to the East line of Eaton Street; thence South on the East line of Eaton Street to the South line of Wheeler Street; thence West on the South line of Wheeler Street to the East line of Main

Street; beginning thence at the Northeast corner of the intersection of Main and Carolina Street; and running thence East on the North line of Carolina Street to the East line of Park Street; thence South on the East line of Park Street to the North line of Isabella Street; thence East on the North line of Isabella Street to the East line of Cleveland Street; thence South on the East line of Cleveland Street to the West bank of the Lebanon and Santiam Canal; thence Southwesterly along the said bank of said Canal to the South line of Oak Street; thence West along the South line of Oak Street to Main Street.

SECTION 2. That in all parts of the City of Lebanon, lying outside the boundaries defined in Section One of this ordinance, all side walks shall be constructed either of concrete, as provided in Section One hereof, or of wood, in the manner now provided by ordinance governing the construction of wood sidewalks, or of gravel and crushed rock and not otherwise; provided that when constructed of gravel and crushed rock there shall always be a top coating of the crushed rock at least 2 inches thick; provided, also, that if any such walk be built of gravel and crushed rock, as herein provided, the same shall be of the width now provided for concrete walks and shall be built on a grade that will permit of using the same as a base for a concrete walk. And provided further that where wood walks are built in connection with gravel and crushed rock walks they shall conform therewith.

SECTION 3. When any sidewalk in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, becomes in such condition from age or any other cause that the same is in a dangerous condition to any person or persons passing over the same and the owner thereof neglects for a period of 72 hours after notice by the street superintendent of the said City or the committee on streets and public property of the common council to repair, rebuild or remove the same, then the said street superintendent is hereby empowered and authorized

and directed to tear up and remove the said walk at once after the end of the said period; and it is further provided that the said notice may be either oral or written.


SECTION 4. That any existing wooden side walk within the cement side walk district, as provided in Section One of this ordinance, may be repaired if, in the opinion of the street committee and superintendent of streets, the same may with safety to the public be repaired, but if the same is in such condition that it cannot be repaired with safety to the public, then the same must be taken out and replaced with a concrete walk, in the manner provided by the ordinances of the City of Lebanon for the building of concrete walks.

SECTION 5. All wooden walks in the City of Lebanon used for side walks, which are now in a dangerous or unsafe condition and all such side walks, which may hereafter become dangerous or in an unsafe condition, are hereby declared to be a public nuisance and shall be torn up and removed as herein provided.

SECTION 6. Ordinance No. 293 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, passed by the Council on the 19th day of September, 1922, and approved by the Mayor on the same date, is hereby repealed.
