

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 2 FOR 1931.

ORDINANCE NO. 418

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE SUPERINTENDENT OF STREETS, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, LINN COUNTY, OREGON, TO PURCHASE CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF LEBANON NOW OFFERED FOR SALE AT PUBLIC AUCTION BY LINN COUNTY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, has a lien, which, together with principal and interest, amounts to the sum of \$ _____, for the improvement of Main Street in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, against the following described real property, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot Two, Block Sixteen, Ralston's Second Addition to Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and running thence North 66 feet; thence West 159 feet; thence South 66 feet; and thence East 159 feet to the place of beginning.

WHEREAS, the taxes became delinquent on said property and the said property was sold on account thereof to Linn County, Oregon, and whereas time for redemption on behalf of the said City has expired; and

WHEREAS, Linn County, Oregon, has advertised said property for sale at public auction to the highest bidder for the purpose of recovering the amount of taxes and costs, for which the same was sold, together with interest thereon; and

WHEREAS, the Council deems it to the best interest of the City of Lebanon to procure title to said property in order to protect its lien against the same.

THEREFORE, the People of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That R. Oldham, Superintendent of Streets of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, be and he is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the said City of Lebanon to attend said sale and to purchase said property at the lowest possible price not in excess of Two Hundred Dollars.

Section 2. Whereas the lien of the City against said property will be forever lost unless said land is purchased by it at said sale and whereas said sale takes place on the 21st day of February, 1931, an emergency is therefore hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
