Ordinance Bill no 8 for 1931
 Ordinance no. 424

A Bill for an ordinance authorizing
 and directing the City Treasurer ^{& Recorder} to borrow
 the sum of Two Thousand Dollars and that
 an ^{interest bearing} warrant issue for thirty days as
 security therefor:

The People of the City of Lebanon do ordain
 as follows:

Sec 1. The City Treasurer & City ~~Recorder~~ ^{Recorder}
 are hereby authorized to borrow the sum of
 \$2000⁰⁰ and ^{that} issue a warrant ^{issue} therefor
 payable on or before 30 days from date
 bearing interest at 8% per annum.

Sec 2. It being necessary that this money be obtained
 at once in order to pay on the 6000⁰⁰ of sewer bonds due
 June 1, 1931. The peace, health & safety of the City of Lebanon
 require this ordinance to be immediately effective. Therefore
 this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from
 and after its passage, and approval by the Mayor.
 Passed by the Council this 25th day of May 1931
