

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 9 FOR 1931.

ORDINANCE NO. 425

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE REGISTRATION OF ALL CATTLE OF EVERY KIND OVER SIX MONTHS OF AGE OWNED AND /OR KEPT WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Every person or persons, or corporation or association ~~xxxx~~ now or hereafter owning or having in their possession, within the corporate limits of Lebanon, Oregon, one or more cattle over six months of age, shall, on or before thirty days from the date of this ordinance, or on or before thirty days from the acquisition of any such livestock, cause the same to be registered with the City Recorder of Lebanon, Oregon, in a book to be provided by the said Recorder at the expense of the said City, which said book shall be open for inspection by any State, County, or municipal veterinarian or health officer.

Section 2. The fee for registering any of said live stock shall be 10 cts. per head to be paid by the owner thereof or by the person or persons having lawful possession thereof at the time of registration.

Section 3. The City Recorder, at the time of making such registration shall take from the owner or person in possession of such live stock a description thereof, sufficient for identification, and shall at said time also take the name and address of such owner or person having possession thereof.

Section 4. Any person, persons, corporation or association violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall, on conviction thereof before the City Recorder, be fined not ~~xxxx~~ more than \$5.00.
