ORDINANCE NO. 435

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING CLERKS AND JUDGES FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING THE ELECTION TO BE HELD MAY 20TH TO VOTE ON THE CHARTER AMENDMENT PROPOSED BY INITIATIVE PETITION.

WHEREAS, an initiative petition has been duly prepared, signed and filed with the Recorder of the City of Lebanon under date of _____, demanding that a Charter amendment be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Lebanon for their approval or ~~re~~^{re}jection at the regular election to be held in said City on the 20th day of May, 1932, having for its purpose the amendment of Section 34, Article 1, Chapter 3, of said Charter; and

WHEREAS, said date is the day of the general primary election throughout the State of Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the County Court of Linn County, Oregon, has duly appointed the clerks and judges of the several precincts in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, to conduct said general primary election; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon, by amendment to its Charter, has put in force the provision of Section 14A, Article 2, of the Constitution of the State of Oregon relating to the holding of elections; THEREFORE

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the clerks and judges of election, appointed by the County Court of Linn County, Oregon, for the several precincts in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, be and they are hereby appointed to act as clerks and judges, respectively, for conducting the election whereby said Charter

amendment, above referred to, is to be voted on.

SECTION 3. In as much as the time for said election is not thirty days away, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
