ORDINANCE BILL NO. /- /933 FOR 1933 ORDINANCE NO. 438

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE SALARIES OF THE SEVERAL OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, LINN COUNTY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND REFALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. The salaries of the several officers of the City of Lebanon shall be as follows:

> City Recorder \$80.00 per month; City Treasurer \$15.00 per month; City Attorney \$25.00 per month; Marshal \$90.00 per month, and \$10.00 per month as Street Commissioner; Night Watchman \$90.00 per month; Superintendent of Streets \$25.00 per month and \$25.00 per month for full time manual labor on the streets;
> Mayor and Council \$2.00 each per meeting; Health Officer \$40.00 per year, which shall be in full for all work done by him at the City expense; City Engineer \$2.00 for the establishment of each grade.

Section II. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section III. Owing to the world wide depression and to the necessity of reducing expenses of the City for the current year, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
