

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 7 FOR 1933

ORDINANCE NO. 444

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 97 PASSED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 5TH DAY OF MAY, 1910 AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR ON THE 8TH DAY OF MAY, 1910, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A CURB LINE ON THE STREETS OF LEBANON, AND TO PROVIDE THE MANNER OF CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS" AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH:

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That section 1 of Ordinance No. 97 passed by the Council on the 5th day of May, 1910, and approved by the Mayor on the 8th day of May, 1910, entitled "An Ordinance to provide the manner of constructing of Curbs, and to repeal all ordinances in conflict therewith" be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That all curbs constructed hereafter on Main Street from B. Street South to the South line of the City limits and on Maple Street from Park Street to Second Street shall be ten feet from the property line abutting on said Streets.
