A BIL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 283 OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO LICENSE AND REGULATE THE USE OF GASOLINE PUMPS AND GASOLINE STATIONS IN THE STREETS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON."

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 283 of the City of Lebanon, passed by the Council on the 21st day of February, 1922, and approved by the Mayor on the 21st day of February, 1922, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. From and after the first day of April, 1922, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, co-partnership or corporation to use, maintain or have any gasoline pump or gasoline station in or on any street in the city of Lebanon, without first procuring a permit therefor and pay the license fees therefor as herein provided; and that from and after the 16th day of January, 1934, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, co-partnership or corporation to erect, install or maintain any gasoline or fuel pump or gasoline station in or on any street in said city other than those already constructed and in use on said date."

Passed by the Council this 16th day of January, 1934.
