ORDINANCE NO. 452

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 446, OTHERWISE DESIGNATED AS ORDINANCE BILL NO. 10 FOR 1933, AMENDATORY OF ORDINANCE NO. 26 OF THE CITY OF LEBANON; AND PRESCRIBING CERTAIN CONDITIONS INCIDENT TO SUCH REPEAL.


THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 446 of the City of Lebanon, also designated as Ordinance Bill No. 10 for 1933, duly passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 18th day of July, 1933, amending Ordinance No. 26 duly passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 20th day of September, 1892, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That the express purpose of this ordinance is to place Ordinance No. 26 hereinbefore referred to in the same status as existed prior to the enactment of said Ordinance No. 446, otherwise designated as Ordinance Bill No. 10 for 1933, and the City of Lebanon by the repeal of said Ordinance No. 446 does not thereby give any further recognition or any further validity to said Ordinance No. 26 than already existed prior to the passage of said Ordinance No. 446 which is hereby repealed.
