ORDINANCE BILL NO. 2 FOR 1934. ORDINANCE NO. 459

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SUNDAY AND ELECTION DAYS IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, AND PROVIDING THE PENALTY THEREFOR.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to sell or offer for sale within the corporate limits of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, any alcoholic beverages containing more than onehalf of one per cent of alcohol by volume between the hours of 1:00 A.M. Sunday and 7:00 A.M. Monday or during the polling hours on any general or special election in said city.

Section 2. If any person, firm or corporation shall be convicted of a Violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance, he shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the City jail for not more than 50 days, or by both said fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public peace, health, safety and morals, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
