

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 5 FOR 1935

ORDINANCE NO. 466

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A LOADING ZONE ON MAIN STREET BETWEEN ASH AND SHERMAN STREETS, REGULATING THE USE THEREOF, AND THE OPERATION OF PASSENGER VEHICLES FOR HIRE, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the space on the East side of Main Street adjacent to the curb, extending toward the center of said street 8 feet and 25 feet North and 25 feet South along said street from a point at the curb opposite the main entrance to the lobby of the Lebanon Hotel, the same being a space of 8 feet by 50 feet on the surface of said street, is hereby designated as a "Loading Zone".

SECTION 2. That the boundaries of said Loading Zone shall be plainly marked by strips of paint on the surface of said street and on the curb of the sidewalk, and appropriate portable signs shall be placed in plain view on the sidewalk at the curb on the North and South boundaries of said Loading Zone to inform the public that the same is to be used only for a Loading Zone and that parking of private automobiles shall not be permitted therein.

SECTION 3. That it shall be unlawful for any bus, stage, motor, or other vehicle in the business of carrying passengers for hire to stop on Main Street between Ash and Sherman Streets for the purpose of discharging or picking up passengers or luggage, except when said vehicle is parked within the boundaries of said Loading Zone.

SECTION 4. That it shall be unlawful for any motor or other vehicle, other than those mentioned in Section 3 hereof, to park in said Loading Zone, provided; however, that this ordinance shall not be construed to prohibit private motor or other vehicles from stopping in said Loading Zone for the purpose of picking up or discharging passengers.

SECTION 5. Any person, firm or other corporation, its agents or employees, violating any provision of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in the sum not exceeding \$100.00 or be imprisoned in the City Jail not exceeding 10 days, or be punished by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 6. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public peace, health, safety and morals, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
