ordinance bill no. 6 for 1935. ordinance no. 467

A Bill for an Ordinance to ascertain and determine the cost of a certain lateral sewer which the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, heretofore caused to be layed in the within described sewer improvement district: Running Morth along the Alley from Dodge Street to and connecting with the trunk sewer in Wheeler Street in Block One in Kirkpatrick's Second Addition to said City; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of the cost of such improvements to be borne by the property owners to be assessed against each lot, or part thereof, abutting upon and especially benefited by said sewer; and to direct the Recorder of the City of Lebanon to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of March, 1935, the owners of more than 50% of the property abutting upon the proposed sewer improvement district filed with the Council of the City of Lebanon their petition for the laying of a lateral sewer along the alleys of the City of Lebanon as follows, to-wit:

Running North along the Alley from Dodge Street to and connecting with the trunk sewer in Wheeler Street in Block One in Kirkpatrick's Second Addition to said City,

and asking that the cost of materials to be used be assessed against the property abutting and especially benefited by said sewer and asking that the remainder of the cost thereof be borne by said City and the Civil Works Administration and waiving, advertising or calling for bids therefor and notice of intention to make said improvement, or any further notice of any kind for making said improvement, and

WHEREAS' said Council did on the 19th day of March, 1935, by Resolution No. 4 for 1935, order the City Engineer to make plans, specifications and estimates of the proposed lateral

sewer, and ordered that the cost of the tile and materials be assessed to the owners of the abutting real property especially benefited thereby, and that the same be made a lien upon and charged against said real property, and

WHEREAS, said plans, specifications and estimates were filed with the City Recorder by said City Engineer on April 16, 1935, and approved, and

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of April, 1935, the Common Council of said City by Resolution No. 5 approved and accepted said plans and specifications, and,

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of April, 1935, the Commom Council by Resolution No. 6 for 1935, did declare its intention to construct said lateral sewer and set aside from funds not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$600 for the payment of supervision and contribution to the State Industrial Accident Commission for the labor used on said project and as an advancement of the cost of materials to be used on said project, provided, however, that the owners of the property abutting on said improvement should reimburse the City for any outlay by it on account of any materials used thereon, and

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of April, 1935, the Common Council did by Resolution No. 7 for 1935, authorize and direct the City Recorder of said City to notify in writing the owners of the property abutting on said proposed lateral sewer that an a sessment would be levied against such abutting property for the cost of said materials at a regular meeting of the City Council of this City, to be held on Tuesday, May 7, 1935, at 7:30 P.M. at the Council of Chambers in the City Hall, and that objections thereto, if any, shall be heard said time and place.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the cost of materials for laying the

lateral sewer in said improvement district which sum is to be borne by the property abutting upon and especially benefited by, is the sum of \$262.40.

Section 2. It is hereby determined that the cost of the contribution to the State Industrial Accident Commission for the labor used on said project, and for the supervision thereof, which cost is to be borne by the City of Lebanon, is \$.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said cost of said improvement to be borne by the real property abutting thereon and to be assessed upon said lots, or parts thereof, is hereby ascertained and declared to be the amounts set and placed immediately after the separate description of each such lots, or parts of lots, and each of said lots, or parts thereof, is determined and declared to be benefited by said improvement in a sum equal to, or greater than, the amount herein assessed against the same as follows, to-wit:
