ORDINANCE BILL NO. 8 FOR 1935.

ORDINANCE NO. 468

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING VEHICLES FROM FOLLOW-ING FIRE APPARATUS AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PUNISHMENT OF ANY VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle, including bicycles and motorcycles, other than one on official business to follow any fire apparatus traveling in response to a fire alarm, or during a fire drill, closer than five hundred feet, or to travel into or park such vehicle or conveyance within the block where fire apparatus has stopped in answer to a fire alarm, or during a fire drill, or within three blocks of a point where a fire is in progress.

Section 2. That any person violating this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in the sum not exceeding \$100.00 or be imprisoned in the city jail not exceeding 10 days, or be punished by both such fine and imprisonment.
