

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 10 FOR 1935 .

ORDINANCE NO. 471

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR HOLDING A SPECIAL ELECTION ON FRIDAY, THE 31st DAY OF JANUARY, 1936, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, COUNTY OF LINN, STATE OF OREGON, THE QUESTION OF VOTING NOT TO EXCEED \$8000.00 IN TEN YEAR BONDS TO BEAR NOT TO EXCEED FIVE PER CENT INTEREST TO PROVIDE MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF A FIRE PUMPER FOR ADDITIONAL FIRE PROTECTION FOR SAID CITY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there shall be held in the City of Lebanon, County of Linn, State of Oregon, on Friday, January 31, 1936, a special election for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of said City the question of issuing bonds of said City in a sum not to exceed \$8000.00, and bearing not to exceed five per cent interest, payable semi-annually in denominations of \$500.00, for the purpose of obtaining money to purchase a fire pumper to supplement the present fire fighting equipment of said City, and provide more adequate protection to the citizens and property in said City against loss by fire; provided that any surplus money derived from the sale of said bonds and not necessary to be used for the purchase of said fire pumper may be used for the purchase of additional fire fighting equipment for said City.

Section 2. That said fire pumper shall be of 600 gallon capacity, of standard motor driven type, and shall be approved by the National Board of Underwriters.

Section 3. That, since there is property of great value in said City not now adequately protected against loss by fire, and, since said pumper and equipment to be used in connection there with are necessary to supplement the present fire fighting equipment of said City to provide more adequate protection, the Common Council of said City hereby declares an emergency to exist, and this Ordinance, being necessary for the immediate

protection of public peace, health, safety and morals, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
