ordinance bill no. 3 for 1935. ordinance no. 464

A Bill for an Ordinance to ascertain and determine the cost of a certain lateral sewer which the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, heretofore caused to be layed in the within described sewer improvement district: From Main Street West on North Main and Morton Streets to Second Street, north on Second Street to Mary Street and West on Harrison Street from Second Street to Third Street; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of the cost of such improvements to be borne by the property owners to be assessed against each lot, or part thereof, abutting upon and especially benefited by said sewer; and to direct the Recorder of the City of Lebanon to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of March, 1934, the owners of more than 50% of the property abutting upon the proposed sewer improvement district filed with the Council of the City of Lebanon, their petition for the laying of a lateral sewer along the streets of the City of Lebanon as follows, to-wit:

From Main Street west on North Main and Morton Streets to Second Street, north on Second Street to Mary Street and west on Harrison Street from Second Street to Third Street,

and asking that the cost of materials to be used be assessed against the property abutting and especially benefited by said sewer and asking that the remainder of the cost thereof be borne by said City and the Civil Works Administration and waiving, advertising or calling for bids therefor and notice of intention to make said improvement, or any further notice of any kind for making said improvement, and

WHEREAS, said Council did on the 20th day of March, 1934, by Resolution No. 3 for 1934, ordered the City Engineer to make

plans, specifications and estimates of the proposed lateral sewer, and ordered that the cost of the tile and materials be assessed to the owners of the abutting real property especially benefited thereby, and that the same be made a lien upon and charged against said real property, and

WHEREAS, said plans, specifications and estimates were filed with the City Recorder by said City Engineer on April 17, 1934, and approved, and

WHEREAS, on the 18th day of September, 1934, a motion was made and approved by the Council of said City that the City proceed with the construction of said sewer in said sewer improvement district in conjunction with the Civil Works Administration, the City to assume the cost of supervision and the contribution to the State Industrial Accident Commission for the labor employed, and

WHEREAS, said Council did on the 5th day of March, 1935, instruct the City Recorder to ascertain and determine the proportion of the cost of said improvement to be borne by the property owners abutting said lateral sewer.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the cost of materials for laying the lateral sewer in said improvement district which sum is to be borne by the property abutting upon and especially benefited by is the sum of \$1137.26.

Section 2: It is hereby determined that the cost of the contribution to the State Industrial Accident Commission for the labor used on said project, and for the supervision thereof, which cost is to be borne by the City of Lebanon is \$488.05.

Section 3: That the proportionate share of said cost of said improvement to be borne by the real property abutting thereon and to be assessed upon said lots, or parts thereof, is hereby ascertained and declared to be the amounts set and

placed immediately after the separate description of each such lots, or parts of lots, and each of said lots, or parts thereof, is determined and declared to be benefited by said improvement in a sum equal to, or greater than, the amount herein assessed against the same as follows, to-wit:
