

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 8 FOR 1936

ORDINANCE NO. 478

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE RECKLESS DRIVING, RUNNING OR OPERATING OF ANY AUTOMOBILE, TRUCK, MOTORCYCLE OR ANY OTHER MOTOR VEHICLE IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive, run or operate any automobile, truck, motorcycle or any other motor vehicle upon or over any highway, street or thoroughfare within the City of Lebanon, Oregon, carelessly and heedlessly in wilful or wanton disregard of the rights or safety of others or without due caution and circumspection and at a speed or in a manner so as to endanger or be likely to endanger any person or property.

Section 2. Any person who shall be found guilty of the violation of Section 1 of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof in the Recorder's Court, be fined in a sum not exceeding \$100.00, or be imprisoned in the city jail not exceeding ten days, or be punished by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public peace, health, safety and morals, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
